#### **Job Summary**

To mobilize, attract, and retain beneficiaries to utilize organisational services by promoting the organisation, its campaigns, and resources within disadvantaged communities. The Peer Educator will also create and maintain positive relationships with beneficiaries, community structures, and existing stakeholders.

#### **Main Tasks and Responsibilities**

- Build and maintain strong relationships with beneficiaries, community organisations, safe spaces, and clinics. Provide health education and distribute condoms and lubricants to promote safer behaviours.
- Promote organisational services and encourage uptake of HTS, STI screening, and other health services.
- Support HTS counselling and facilitate linkage to care.
- Gather and share community feedback to improve service access and delivery.
- Participate in community meetings, stakeholder engagements, and outreach activities.

#### **Minimum Requirements**

- HIV and AIDS Testing and Counselling certificate
- Ability work with minimal supervision and be deadline driven
- Ability to work in a pressurized environment
- Two year experience in a similar position and working with the key populations
